

Draft of March 4, 2019 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Jonathan MacKenzie; Trustees Charles Edwards, Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell, Joseph Lohret; Clerk Joyann Stimpson; Journal Reporter Cait Johnston; and Doris Nichols.

Meeting called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Trustee McDowell brought to the Boards attention that some residents were concerned about their neighbors not clearing their sidewalks of snow. She asked the Board if the Village could look into the cost of getting equipment to clear the sidewalks for the residents. Trustee McDowell is going to contact other Villages to see what they have and the cost.

On a motion made by Trustee Lohret; seconded by Trustee McCotter; and carried, the Board appointed Kaaren Evens, Phyllis Snell, and Nancy and Tom Smith to be Election Inspectors for the March 19, 2019 Village elections.

All agreed that the work crew that handled to water main break at the Rescue Squad did a great job. However there was a problem with the reverse 911 calls but that was a problem at the county level.
