Meeting called to order at 5:34 P.M.

Board discussed the DOT letter sent to Jean Lufkin regarding crosswalks in the Village.

Commissioner Robinson gave water report

- motor at well #2 burned out, possibly caused by a faulty connection, and had to be replaced
- Cutting Edge to do directional drilling and may take a week to do
- Presbyterian Church has given the Village easements for the drilling and connecting of the new well
- the Village will need to hire Ashcroft for some of the work

Clerk asked about purchasing a shredder, Mayor offered one.
