

July 1, 2020 Argyle Village Board Meeting  
(Virtual)

Those in attendance; Mayor Jonathan MacKenzie, Trustees Wesley Clark, Cher McCotter, Anthony Montello, Water Commissioner Garry Robinson, Clerk Joyann Stimpson, and Faith St. John.

Meeting called to order at 5:32.

Mayor MacKenzie asked Board to consider putting in crosswalks across Main Street and possibly Sheridan Street. The crosswalks need to be handicap accessible and we need to determine the estimated cost.

Water Commissioner Robinson updated the Board on water and sewer.

- water levels are good and well #2 is pumping normally
- Tom Davey from Cutting Edge could do the work on the new well for \$41, 000.00
- will take about 10 days start to finish
- will need to have attorney to go over the easement papers from Argyle Presbyterian Church
- the drilling will have no effect on the ball fields and they will be getting their own lighting

Commissioner Robinson reminded the Board that infra-structure money may be available for sewer and updated plans and designs have to be done as well as the next phase of the archeological study.

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter, seconded by Trustee Clark, and carried, the Clerk was allowed to pay warrants for the month of July.
